INSTRUCTIONS AFTER A DENTAL CLEANING

- Your animal was started on a regimen of antibiotics prior to their dental cleaning, continue tomorrow and continue until the antibiotics are finished
- No antibiotics needed
- The doctor has prescribed antibiotics for your animal, begin tomorrow and continue until antibiotics are finished

- Tooth extractions usually do not cause any problems. Most animals are able to eat their regular diet by the following day.

- There are several ways to cut down on the tartar build-up on your pet's teeth, after they have had their teeth professionally cleaned by us:
 - **Brush the teeth** with special toothpaste made for animals. *We prefer **C.E.T. brand toothpaste.***
 - Do this three times a week or more, if possible.
 - **Do NOT** use a human toothpaste on your pets' teeth
 - **Feed Hill's brand T/D diet.** This food is designed to scrape tartar from a dog's teeth. We have seen tremendous results from the use of T/D. This diet is available for cats and dogs.
