INSTRUCTIONS AFTER A DENTAL CLEANING

Your animal was started on a regimen of antibiotics prior to their dental cleaning, continue tomorrow and continue until the antibiotics are finished
No antibiotics needed
The doctor has prescribed antibiotics for your animal, begin tomorrow and continue until antibiotics are finished
Tooth extractions usually do not cause any problems. Most animals are able to eat their regular diet by the following day.
 There are several ways to cut down on the tartar build-up on your pet's teeth, after they have had their teeth professionally cleaned by us: Brush the teeth with special toothpaste made for animals. We prefer C.E.T. brance toothpaste. Do this three times a week or more, if possible. Do NOT use a human toothpaste on your pets' teeth Feed a prescription veterinary diet. These foods are designed to scrape tartar from your pet's teeth while they chew. We have seen tremendous results from the use of these diets. tional Recommendations for your pet:
